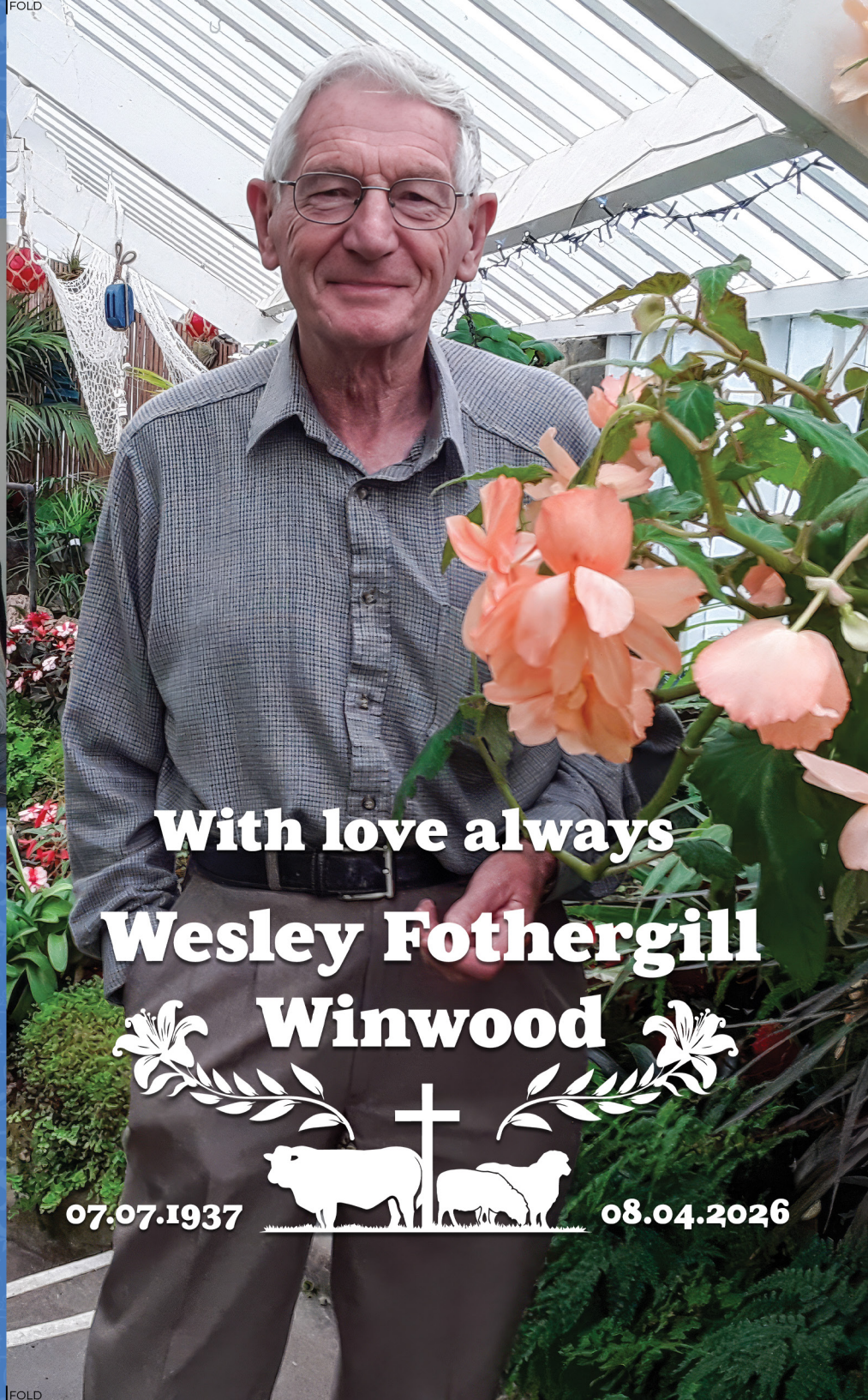

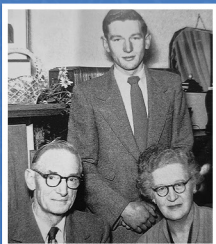

Mitchell St, Invercargill where Wes was born and moved out of in 1960 at the age of 23.



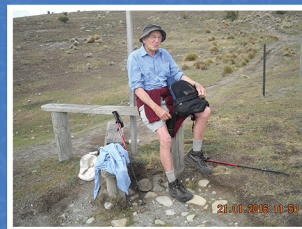
Wes and his 21st birthday with his mother and father.

Wrights Bush from 1969 - 1999 and the Makarewa Freezing works where dad spent 25 years at.



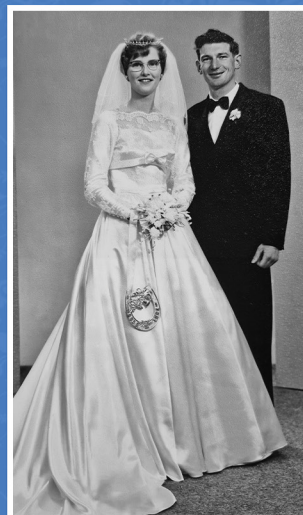
Ashburton 1999 - 2019 where hiking and biking burst onto the scene for Wes and Ed.



Wes with Derek and Grant at Riverton Rocks.



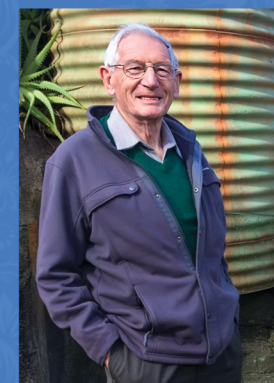
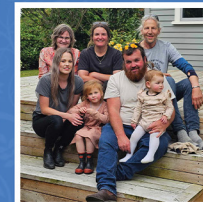
Wes and Ed as a married couple at Waimahaka 1964 - 1969.
